It offers a Par 66 9 holes over a course covering 4878 metres.

Golf carts are optional and not a "must". Competing or practising in this peaceful oasis raises spirits and relaxes minds when admiring the around 70 km-long Claudius Aqueduct, first started by the Tyrant-Emperor Caius Julius Caesar, better known as Caligula, in 38 A.D. and completed by Emperor Claudius in 52 A.D.

A Seventeenth Century residence, once the home to Cardinals, overlooking a volcanic crater, it is today judged to be the most beautiful of all golf Club Houses. Robert Trent Jones' imaginative design has turned the crater into a challenging golf course, which comprises a number of interesting technical twists. The ground, a natural golf course, boasts 96 bunkers, 3 ponds, artificial obstacles as well as thousands of other mouth-watering difficulties scattered among aged-old olive, oak and pine trees. A stunning view of the entire golf course may be enjoyed from the building's terrace, taking in every one of its 18 holes in a single awe-inspiring gaze. Darren Clarke, Retief Goosen, Costantino Rocca, Eduardo Romero, Sam Torrance and Van De Velde are just some of the many champions who have tested their skills on Country Club Castelgandolfo's 6222 m course during the various European Tour trials which have been held here.

Go straight on for 3,300 km until No. 234. Turn left just before the sign post for "Pavona". After 50 metres, left again into Via S. Spirito.

The mild climate of the winter and cool of the summer ensures play is possible throughout the year, while its proximity to the capital, its interesting naturalistic surroundings (located 3 km away the “Landriana Gardens”, and little further on also from the “Ninfa Oasis”) as well as the well-known seaside resorts stretching from Anzio to Circeo, from Sabaudia to Sperlonga, make it a favourite spot for international tourism.

From Rome: leave the ring road (G.R.A.) at Exit 26 heading towards Pomezia on the via Pontina; after 25 km turn right in the direction of Anzio-Nettuno, drive another 4 km to Anzio-Nettuno, following the sign-posts. Altitude: 80 metres above sea level.

From Fiumicino: head towards Ostia until you reach the coast, turn left for Anzio, drive another 23 km before taking the left turn into Viale Firenze, after 100 metres it is the right turning into Viale Bolzano.

Olgiata's Residential Complex was built in an area that is part of the land once belonging to the ancient and powerful town of Veio. It is situated not far from Isola Farnese, where the baronial castle of the noble family of the Orisinis was erected around 154 B.C. on the consular road Via Cassia which was in turn commissioned by the Magistrate Caius Cassius Longino. The buildings were constructed mostly using the ruins of the town of Veio, which was conquered and destroyed by the Romans in 396 B.C. Towards the end of the Fifties, the fabulous green oasis on the Cassia, just a few kilometres from Capitol Hill, seemed the ideal spot for a new golf course. This is how the company "Società Generale Immobiliare", the owners of that small natural piece of paradise, where the World Champion Horse Racers Nearco, Tenerani and Ribot first started out from the stables of Dormello-Olgiata, became a residential complex, quickly turning also into a sports centre with a golf course, swimming pools and tennis courts.

Its name derives from the fact that Pope Leo X, formerly Giovanni de' Medici, son of Lorenzo The Magnificent (the real protagonist of his age, the Renaissance), chose to spend a great deal of time in this area. Leo X used to stay in a residence originally built as a hunting lodge by Innocent VIII; however grand extension work commissioned by his successors (Alexander VI, Julius II and by Leo X himself) had turned it into a sumptuous villa which eventually came to be known as the "Castle of the Magliana" or "Castle of the Popes" due to its battlements. Famous artists also had a hand in the building work including Bramante, Sangallo and Raphael himself, whose fresco decorating the apse's basin is of particular note, but which sadly was removed and sent to France at the end of the Nineteenth Century where it today numbers among the Italian works housed in the Louvre.
